The product naming convention, which encompasses all levels of TEMPEST, is designed to be descriptive rather than follow particular test standards and to reflect SST's marketplace and capability.

<b>TT</b>	Tactical (SDIP-27 Level C, AMSG-784, NSTISSAM /I-92 Level III, NATO Zone 2)

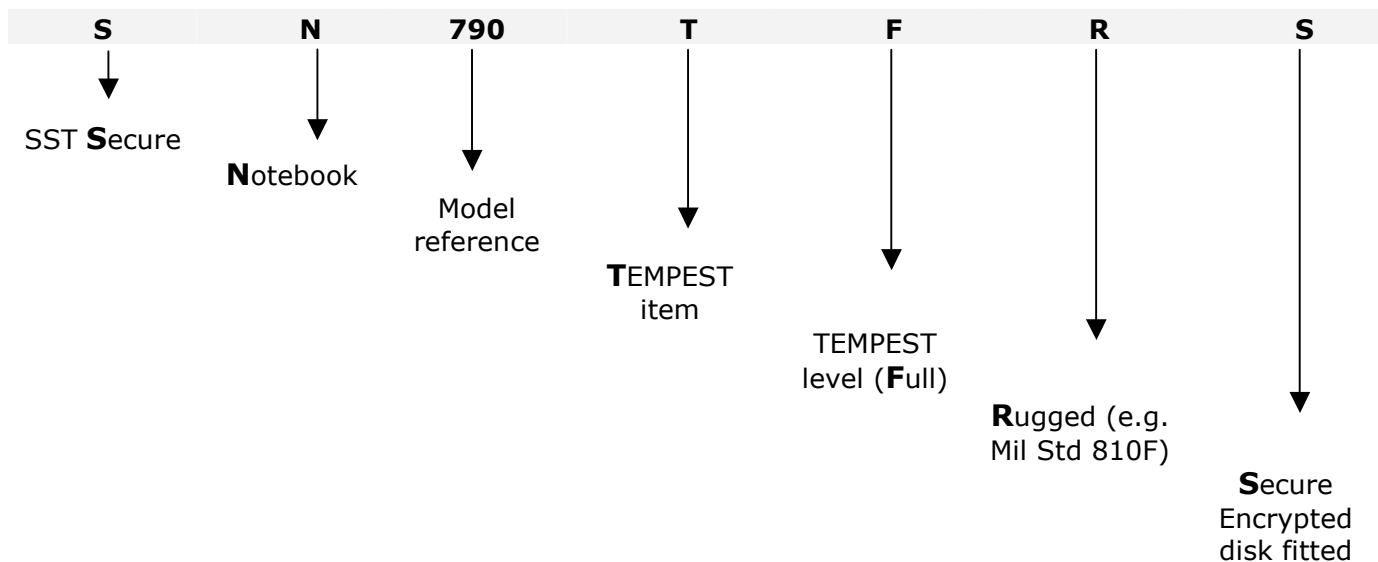
